

Heartland Data Breach

Heartland, a New Jersey based credit and debit card processor, suffered a large-scale unauthorized intrusion into its computer systems. They found malicious software on their network and consumers' card data was compromised by this software. They report the intrusion has been contained and additional steps taken to secure their systems. Most recently, individuals suspected of perpetrating the crime have been arrested. They advise Social Security Number data was **NOT** compromised.

We have been working with Visa to determine members impacted by the breach. We have personally called all members that were impacted. Rest assured we do not hold members liable for fraudulent credit card charges.

No matter the circumstances, a good financial habit to adopt is the regular monitoring of all your accounts and reporting anything fraudulent to us immediately.
